Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Plan and deliver lessons utilizing creative and engaging techniques that reach students.
- Prepare academic materials, including homework assignments, syllabi and instructional handouts.
- Report to the Instructional Team Leader monthly regarding the effectiveness of concepts.
- Facilitate classroom discussions and encourage the participation of all students, incorporating relevant reading and current events.
- Grade papers, tests and homework, monitoring progress and adapting lesson plans to meet students' needs.
- Assess individual strengths, weaknesses, and opportunities of each student, addressing issues as needed.
- Maintain working knowledge of college standards and instill confidence in students' capability to demonstrate knowledge gained during the school year.
- Uphold clearly communicated rules and behavior expectations for a disciplined and inclusive classroom setting.
- Communicate with parents when necessary regarding noteworthy achievements, academic challenges, special considerations or concerns you feel their child needs to succeed.
- Obtain and use evaluative findings (including student achievement data) to determine course effectiveness and ensure that courses are continuous and respond to student needs.
- Accompany and supervise students on out-of-town trips.

- Attending school events, club meetings, and staff meetings as required.
- Building rapport with students so that they feel comfortable and safe discussing sensitive topics in class.
- Encouraging students to participate in science fairs, competitions, and expos, and preparing them for these events.
