GRADE 6

The following is a suggested list of supplies for 6th grade students to be purchased by the first day of school. Please label ALL supplies with the student's name.

General Organizational Supplies:

- o Binder with dividers – Math, Reading, English, Bible, Science, Geography
- o 4 highlighters (2 colors)
- o Erasable pens, blue/black ink pens, pencils
- o 4 red pens for checking
- o Colored pencils, crayons and markers
- o Small pencil sharpener

- o Solar calculator (inexpensive)
- o Scissors and glue
- o Plastic re-sealable bags – 1 box each sandwich size and gallon size (bring to school when needed)

Band 6 / Instrumental Exploratory

If you are a true beginner: Due to the need for specialized PPE and the inherent challenges of starting a new instrument in a group setting, only those who have already had instruction (at CCA or otherwise) may play wind instruments. New members who are true beginners must choose between percussion and violin until we are able to play 100% in person without PPE.

Those who have had previous instruction on brass and woodwind instruments may continue to play them using CCA supplied PPE for both the player and their instrument. All woodwind and brass players must supply their own maintenance supplies to avoid sharing:

All Percussionists including those temporarily switching need to provide

1. their own beginning percussion kit including glockenspiel (bell set), mallets, drum pad, stand for drum pad, music stand, and drum sticks. GRADES 7 and 8

Band

Because band presents unique challenges regarding aerosols and air flow, **CCA will be providing specialized PPE for all wind players** and their instruments (specialized masks, bell covers, clarinet/sax "bags", disposable condensation rags for brass players, etc.)

Anyone concerned about the safety of playing a wind instrument is welcome to switch to percussion or violin indefinitely until the student and their family choose to resume wind instrument playing.
